Schools funding – Ten year average annual growth rates by state and sector

Question

Please provide the average annual growth rate (ten year period) for each state government school system, each approved catholic school authority and average for each independent sector in each state.

Answer

The following table provides average per student funding in 2017 and 2027 by state/territory and sector and the corresponding average annual growth per student over 2018 to 2027. Average annual growth figures are calculated with 2017 as the starting point but are labelled from 2018 as the first year of growth.
