Question

FWO - Number of investigations upheld

Senator RUSTON: Yes. If you investigated 259 of them, did you find that there was a small percentage of them that were upheld? Or a large percentage of them? Mr Campbell: I will probably have to come back to you about that on notice, if I could. I think we covered this ground at the last estimates, but I will happily come back to you. I can remember discussion about this, but I just do not have the information you seek right now.

Answer

Of the 259 complaints completed by the Fair Work Ombudsman relating to 457 visa holders during the 2012-13 financial year, 33 per cent of the complaints were sustained.
