Question

Demand driven system to sub bachelor courses

Can you outline the funding profile, over the forward estimates, for extension of the demand driven system to sub bachelor courses for existing Table A providers (universities)?

Answer

The extension of the demand driven funding system to sub-bachelor level places at all higher education institutions accredited by the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency has the following financial impact (Commonwealth Grants Scheme and Higher Education Contribution Scheme).

The financial impact is as at the 2014-15 Budget. The Department did not apportion this cost to different types of institutions (i.e. universities and non-university higher education institutions).
