Including details of meeting at a department or ministerial level, and information about what was discussed and decided? c. Can the Department provide a breakdown of numbers of position under the new program by state? And are you able to contrast that with the total number of chaplains and student welfare officers employed under the current School Chaplaincy and Student Welfare Program?
