Answer

There is one Act in the Employment Portfolio with a sunset provision.

Fair Work (Building Industry) Act 2012

Section 46 of the *Fair Work (Building Industry) Act 2012* provides that the Director of the Fair Work Building Industry Inspectorate may not make an application to a nominated Administrative Appeals Tribunal presidential member for an examination notice under section 45 after the end of three years after the day on which that section commences.

Section 45 commenced on 1 June 2012, therefore applications may not be made from 1 June 2015.

1. What work has been done towards preparing for the activation of sunset provisions? If no work has commenced, why not?

The Building and Construction Industry (Improving Productivity) Bill 2013 and the Building and Construction Industry (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2013, which will re-establish the Australian Building and Construction Commission as the specialist workplace relations regulator for the building and construction industry, passed the House of Representatives on 12 December 2013. These Bills are currently before the Senate.

Item 1 of Schedule 1 to the Building and Construction Industry (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2013 will repeal the *Fair Work (Building Industry) Act 2012* in its entirety, including section 46 (which is a sunset provision relevant to examination notices).

Part 2 of Chapter 7 of the Building and Construction Industry (Improving Productivity) Bill 2013 contains new examination notice provisions.
