#### Question

## **FWO - Unallocated Equipment**

1. Please detail how much electrical equipment, phones and computers the department/agency has in storage or unallocated to staff 2. Please detail the purchase, storage and ongoing costs associated with equipment, phones and computers in storage or unallocated.

### **Answer**

1. The Fair Work Ombudsman has 67 19-inch monitors, 49 24-inch monitors and 155 computers in storage and unallocated to staff.

The Fair Work Ombudsman does not own or purchase desktop phones. The agency's phones are supplied under the IT Memorandum of Understanding service arrangements with the Department of Employment and the Department of Education's Shared Services Centre; or with Optus in relation to the Infoline. Any unallocated phone is managed by the provider.

- 2. The asset (book) value of each computer is:
  - DellOptiPlex 980 with dual 19 inch monitor: \$277.78
  - Dell OptiPlex 980 with 24 inch monitor: \$250.00

Note: All Fair Work Ombudsman assets were revalued by an external valuer at 30 June 2014. This resulted in the values of some assets, including computers, increasing from previously reported values.

The asset (book) value of each 19 inch monitor and each 24 inch monitor is unknown as they were not purchased separately, but as part of the computers.

There are no storage costs specifically associated with the unallocated computers and monitors.
