FWBC - Criminal history records

Please provide details of how FWBC obtains criminal history records of individuals:

- a. From which agency or agencies are criminal history records obtained?
- b. Are criminal history records obtained pursuant to formal or informal requests? If through informal requests, who has made requests, to whom have requests been made and in what form have criminal history records been provided? If they are obtained through formal requests, what is the process by which they are made and to whom?
- c. Does FWBC provide reasons to the supplying agency for seeking criminal history records? If so, are records kept of the reasons given?
- d. On what lawful authority does FWBC obtain criminal history records?
- e. Are records of requests for criminal history records kept by FWBC? If so, what is the form of the records?
- f. What procedures are in place to protect criminal history records in the possession of FWBC from unlawful or inappropriate disclosure?
- g. How many individual criminal history records has FWBC obtained since 21 October 2013?
- h. Please provide a breakdown by state and territory jurisdiction of the criminal history records FWBC has obtained?
