Question

FWBC - Applications lodged with FWC

2. Please provide details of the section/s of the Fair Work Act 2009 under which applications have been made, including the number of applications made under each of the nominated sections, involving a building industry participant and of which FWBC has been notified of by the Fair Work Commission?
3. What information is contained in the notifications of applications involving industry participants given by the FWC to FWBC?
