Question

Work for the Dole regional breakdown

Senator O'NEILL: How many jobseekers are currently in Work for the Dole?

Mr Hehir: I think it is in the order of about 29,000 currently, but I will check my figures.

Senator O'NEILL: Can you provide a breakdown by region and age?

Mr Hehir: At 30 September there were 28,414 point in time. Of course, there are more people who have commenced than that because people sometimes get jobs after they have commenced or commence in a couple of different roles. There has been over—

Senator O'NEILL: What was the date?

Mr Hehir: 30 September. I do not have the regional breakdown with me in the detail. There are 51 regions so I do not have that with me here, but I am happy to take that on notice.
