FWO - Right of entry permit

Ms Webster: Certainly. The second matter was handed down on 31 October 2012. This was also a matter which involved Mr Tracey; the MUA and Mr Tracey were respondents. It, too, was an industrial action matter, and this time it occurred at the Broome Port Authority on 30 March 2010. In this matter penalties of \$13,200 were laid against the MUA and \$3,630 against Mr Tracey for organising the unlawful industrial action in those matters. Senator JOHNSTON: Does he still have his right-of-entry permit? Ms Webster: I would have to take that on notice.

Answer

The Fair Work Commission is responsible for issuing right of entry permits under s.512 of the Fair Work Act 2009.
