#### Question

#### Youth Wage Subsidy

This was a wage subsidy of up to 6,500 paid to eligible employers who hire a Job Seeker under 30 years old who have been unemployed for more than 6 months. From 1 July 2015 - can you please clarify if it still exists?

1. Does this wage subsidy still exist in the wages pool?

2. If YES - how many job employers are currently on track to receive this payment?

a. What is the breakdown by age;

b. What is the breakdown by state;

c. How long were they previously unemployed for?

3. If YES – is this subsidy on track to meet its target of the number of job seekers it was to support each year?

## Answer

- 1. Yes, noting this subsidy became available on 1 November 2015.
- 2. As at 27 October the Youth Wage Subsidy had not commenced so there is no data to provide.
- 3. The Youth Wage Subsidy is a demand driven programme and there is no annual target for the number of job seeker places per year.
