Question

Tasmanian Jobs Programme - funding for commencements

- 1. Given the program was budgeted to create 2000, why do you think it hasn't reached this target?
- 2. Can you provide me with the amount of money paid out in total for Tasmanian Jobs Programme for placements/commencements?

Answer

- 1. The Tasmanian Jobs Programme was a trial programme designed to assist job seekers into employment by encouraging employers to hire a candidate they may not have otherwise selected. The take up rate of the Tasmanian Jobs Programme has been influenced by a number of factors which have included the economic conditions in Tasmania. The trial programme was invaluable and has influenced the design of the redeveloped wage subsidy pool which commenced on 1 July 2015. Key features of the redevelopment included more flexible payment structures, additional eligible groups of job seekers and pro-rata payments to employers where employment ends early.
- 2. As at 27 October 2015, \$254,091 has been paid to employers.
