## NCCD/disability loadings - numbers

### Question

What is the current number of students receiving disability loadings in each state?

#### **Answer**

At 27 October 2016, the table below details full time equivalent (FTE) of students with disability attracting the disability loading under the *Australian Education Act 2013* (the Act) in both government and non-government schools.

With regard to the above information, please note the following:

- 1. Data is sourced from the departmental payment system, SEMIS, at 27 October 2016.
- 2. 'Students with disability' is a defined term within section 6 of the Act.
  - a) For non-government students, students with disability meet requirements contained in the 2016 Census of non-government school guidelines.
  - For government schools, students with disability are reported to the department by the respective state or territory as part of the 2015 National Schools Statistical Collection (NSSC).
- 3. The FTE for students at non-government schools is based on the 2016 Census of Non-Government Schools. The FTE for students at government schools is based on the 2015 NSSC.
