***Industry Skills Fund - aged care providers***

**Question**

Are not-for-profit aged care providers eligible to apply for a grant under the ISF programme?  
Are for profit aged care providers eligible to apply for a grant under the ISF programme?

**Answer**

Section 18 of the Industry Skills Fund Program Guidelines identifies that eligible applicants must be solvent Australian enterprises that are non tax-exempt. The nature of not-for-profit providers is not to diversify and improve their competitiveness in a global market which is one of the purposes of the fund.

For profit aged care providers with an identified growth opportunity are eligible to apply.
