Schools funding (independent school)

Question

CHAIR: With one school and its students receiving double the funding of the others. Do you have any examples for independent schools? Mr Cook: An independent school in the ACT would receive 64 per cent more Commonwealth

funding than a comparable independent school in Western Australia. CHAIR: Do we have a figure on what that boils down to at a per-student level? Mr Cook: I do not off the top of my head. We would have to take that on notice.

Answer

The figure of 64 per cent is derived from data published on the MySchool website:

- In 2014, the independent school in the ACT received \$4505 per student from the Australian Government.
- In 2014, the independent school in Western Australia received \$2755 per student from the Government.
- The two schools have comparative levels of need.
