Question

jobactive commencements

Since July 2015, how many people have commenced in jobactive and how many have reached 12 months, 24 months and 36 months in the system, broken down by Streams A, B and C?

Answer

Between 1 July 2015 and 25 October 2016:

- 790,857 job seekers commenced in Stream A
- 357,280 job seekers commenced in Stream B
- 171,579 job seekers commenced in Stream C

The table below shows the number of job seekers who commenced in jobactive and have reached 12 months, 24 months or 36 months servicing (including combined servicing for job seekers who transitioned from Job Services Australia to jobactive).
