FWBC - False declaration to a Commonwealth authority

Senator PATERSON: Making a false declaration to a Commonwealth authority is a criminal offence under the Commonwealth Criminal Code. Who made the declaration in Mr Collier's application that falsely claimed he did not have any relevant criminal convictions to declare? Mr Vallence: I do not think we have that information to hand, but I can take it on notice. Senator PATERSON: Okay. Senator PATERSON: Can you also take on notice whether the matter has been referred to the relevant authorities.
