Question

Referrals to Regulators Arising from the Royal Commission

Ms Leon: There are 93 referrals to regulators arising from the royal commission. Some of those are multiple referrals in relation to officials of one union. Others might be only one or two referrals in relation to particular unions. We can tell you what the referrals were, but there are 93 of them and it might take a while.

Senator PATERSON: No, I will not ask you to do that. You might need to take this on notice: of those 93 referrals, how many different unions were involved?

Ms Leon: We can take that on notice

Answer

The Royal Commission into Trade Union Governance and Corruption made a total of 119 referrals; 27 in the interim report and 93 in the final report. Of the total number of referrals, 95 relate to 7 different registered employee organisations. The interim and final reports examined case studies from 8 different registered employee organisations. The remaining referrals relate to organisations which are not registered employee organisations, or individuals who are not union officials.

The registered organisations that are subject to referrals have a number of reporting units as detailed in the table below:
