Answer:

- a) PM&C has spent \$949,070 on office furniture for the period 1 January 2009 to 28 February 2011.
- b) Items purchased include work stations, office chairs, meeting room tables and chairs and mobile storage.
- c) The furniture was purchased for 1 National Circuit Barton, Old Parliament House (for the office of the Australian Information Commissioner and CHOGM Taskforce), 6 O'Connell Street, Sydney (COAG Reform Council) and The Lodge.
