Question:

A decision was taken at the last meeting of COAG on 13 December 2013 not to renew the National Partnership Agreement on Closing the Gap in Indigenous Health Outcomes (NPA). The department advised the Committee during the previous Estimates hearing on 22 November 2013 that State officials had advised that they were waiting for advice from the new government as to their intention with regard to the NPA.

a. Was advice provided to the Minister prior to the COAG meeting on 13 December 2013 about the NPA? Was this advice a written brief?

b. Was the decision not to renew the NPA consistent with this advice?

c. Why did the Government decide not to renew the NPA?

Answer:
