Question:

- 1. Which Minister and department has responsibility for funding the RECOGNISE community awareness campaign for constitutional recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples?
- 2. Has the Minister for Indigenous Affairs or the department consulted with any other Minister or department regarding an increase in funding for RECOGNISE?
- 3. Has the Minister or department officials met with RECOGNISE to discuss future funding needs of the campaign?
- 4. Will the Government commit to an increase in funding for RECOGNISE, given the need to accelerate and expand the campaign?

Answer:

- 1. The Minister for Indigenous Affairs, Senator the Hon Nigel Scullion, and the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) has responsibility for funding the 'Recognise' campaign.
- 2. The Attorney-General, Senator the Hon George Brandis QC and the Minister for Indigenous Affairs are working together on constitutional recognition. The Attorney-General's Department and PM&C are also consulting closely on relevant matters, including funding for 'Recognise'.
- 3. Yes.
- 4. The appropriate level of funding for the campaign is being closely monitored by the Government and regularly discussed with the management of 'Recognise'.
