**Answer:**

The total cost to re-upholster the four (4) x three seater “Norman” lounges in the Cabinet Anteroom was \$32,237.11 and is broken down as follows:

- \$14,637.11 for the leather (Brumby Orange); and
- \$17,600 for the upholstery works.
