Senator FAULKNER: So when did that work take place, please?

Ms Mills: Again, can I take that on notice? It was certainly scheduled to be done—12 months ago, some of that work was scheduled. I would have to get the program of work since then for you.

Senator FAULKNER: Can you, for example, inform us whether it was done before or after last year's election?

Ms Mills: I am not aware of any of the brumby lounges being upholstered since the election.

Answer:

<u>Brumby Grey Leather</u> – re-upholster and conserve three (3) tub chairs in the Prime Minister's sitting room.

The reupholstering commenced in March 2013 and was completed in April 2013.

<u>Brumby Orange Leather</u> – re-upholster four (4) x three seater "Norman" lounges in the Cabinet Anteroom.

The re-upholstering commenced in August 2013 and was completed in November 2013.
