- a. The Parliamentary Library has spent \$186,786 on press clippings from 7 September 2013 to 17 March 2014. The estimated budget for press clipping in 2013-14 is \$272, 000. The Parliamentary Library also subscribes to a social media monitoring service; however, no payments for this service have been made during this reporting period.
 - a. The clips are purchased from iSentia Pty Limited. The social media monitoring is provided by Sentiment Metrics.
- b. \$186,786 has been spent on press clippings from 7 September 2013 to 17 March 2014. No payment for the social media monitoring service has been made during this period.
- c. The press clippings were billed quarterly up to the December quarter 2013. Since January 2014 the service has been billed on a monthly basis. The social media monitoring was a one off payment (\$120,000) made in July 2013.
