- 2. For each service purchased form a provider listed under (d), please provide:
 - a. The name and nature of the service purchased
 - b. Whether the service is one-on-one or group based
 - c. The number of employees who received the service and their employment classification
 - d. The total number of hours involved for all employees (provide a breakdown for each employment classification)
 - e. The total amount spent on the service
 - f. A description of the fees charged (i.e. per hour, complete package)
- 3. Where a service was provided at any location other than the department or agency's own premises, please provide:

 - b. The number of employees who took part on each occasion (provide a breakdown for each employment classification)

Answer

- 1. For the period 1 October 2013 to 31 December 2013, purchase of executive coaching and/or other leadership training services was as follows.
 - a) \$6,402 (ex GST).
 - b) 176 staff in management and leadership roles are eligible for leadership skills development. The staff range in classification from Parliamentary Executive Level 1 (PEL1) to Senior Executive Service (SES).
 - c) 2 employees (SES Band 1) used these services during this period. These are standard courses offered in the APS and no study leave applies.
 - d) The service provider engaged was the Australian Public Service Commission (APSC)

2. Details for services provided by those listed under (d) above is as follows:
