The Queensland Government has agreed that we can release school attendance data for term 3, 2014 for all Queensland RSAS schools.

- There were 8 schools up and 3 schools down on their 2013 term 3 attendance rate.
- There were 4 out of 11 schools that improved on their 2013 term 3 attendance rate by greater than 5 percentage points. Camooweal State School was the standout with an attendance rate 16.1 percentage points higher in term 3 2014 than in term 3 2013.
- Six schools showed a small change between term 3 2013 and term 3 2014, staying within 5
  percentage points of the term 3 2014 attendance rate. However two thirds of those schools posted a
  positive change between term 3 2013 and term 3 2014.
- One school (Lockhart State School) declined by more than 5 percentage points between term 3 2013 and term 3 2014; down 18.6 percentage points.
- Both Pormpuraaw State School and Camooweal State School have improved as the year has progressed with the greatest improvements (relative to 2013) occurring term 3.
- There were on average 8% more students each week attending Qld Government RSAS schools in term 3 2014 compared with term 3 2013.

The Northern Territory Government has agreed that we can release RSAS school attendance data for term 3, 2014 – 29 schools are included.

- Twenty-one out of 29 (72%) NT Government schools attendance rate increased between term 3 2013 and term 3 2014
- The NT had 10 schools that improved their 2014 attendance rate on 2013 by 5 percentage points or more. Numbulwar School was the standout with an attendance rate 17.1 percentage points higher in term 3 2014 than in term 3 2013. Ngukurr School up 14.8 percentage points; Yirrkala School up 12.6 percentage points; and Elliott School up 12.5 percentage points
- Nineteen schools showed a small change in term 3 2014, staying within 5 percentage points of the 2013 attendance rate. However more than half (11) of those schools posted a positive change in comparison with 2013.

- No schools declined by more than 5 percentage points between term 3 2013 and term 3 2014.
- There were 13% more students on average attending NT Government RSAS schools in term 3 2014 compared with term 3 2013.
