Senator PERIS: How many Indigenous businesses are registered with ORIC now? Can you give me the breakdown from 2013-14 and 2015, where you are at now?

Mr Beven: As of today there are 2,670 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporations registered with my office, and each year there are approximately 100 to 200 new corporations registered.

Senator PERIS: So, since the announcement of the Indigenous Advancement Strategy made it almost compulsory that organisations are registered, what has been the uptake? Can you give me a figure of where you were at, say, at the beginning of last year?

Mr Beven: I can take that on notice, but to answer your question, no, we have not seen a substantial increase in the number of new incorporations, and in this financial year we have only seen four entities transferring their registration from a state based scheme across to the legislation that I administer. So, no, we have not seen a major influx of registrations.
