1. How many full time equivalent staff are engaged at 16 March 2015?
2. How many of these positions are (a) on-going and (b) non-ongoing
3. How many redundancies have occurred in 2014/15 to date? How many were (a) voluntary and (b) involuntary

Answers

1. The FTE as at 16 March 2015 is 72.83.
2. 71.83 full time equivalent staff are ongoing, and one position is non-ongoing.
3. Five redundancies have occurred in 2014/15. Four were voluntary and one was involuntary.
