Question:

Did the Prime Minister advise Dr Grimes before he sought a report from the Secretary of PM&C about Dr Grimes' proposed termination?

Answer:

The Prime Minister did not seek a report from the Secretary of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, Mr Thawley.

Based on discussions he had had with Dr Grimes, Mr Thawley concluded that the establishment of a relationship of strong mutual confidence between the Minister for Agriculture and Dr Grimes was not a realistic prospect. Mr Thawley felt that it was unlikely that Dr Grimes could adequately fulfil the statutory role of a Secretary as the principal policy adviser to the Minister.

Mr Thawley consulted Dr Grimes who concurred with this assessment.

Mr Thawley also consulted the Australian Public Service Commissioner, Mr Lloyd, who agreed with Mr Thawley's assessment.

Mr Thawley then provided a report to the Prime Minister under section 59 of the *Public Service Act 1999*, prepared after consultation with Mr Lloyd.
