**Question:**

Why did the Minister for Agriculture, and not the Prime Minister, announce the termination of Dr Paul Grimes as the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture?

Was (a) the Prime Minister's Office and/or (b) the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet consulted on the content of the Minister for Agriculture's media statement relating to Dr Grimes' termination? If so, when and how. If not, why not?

**Answer:**

It is a matter for the Prime Minister whether he or another Minister makes announcements on appointment matters.

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet and the Prime Minister's Office were consulted on the contents of the Minister's announcement. Comments by the Department were conveyed orally.
