Question:

What changes have been made to the role of the Prime Minister and Ministers in the approval of officials' travel?

Why were the arrangements changed?

Can the current arrangements be outlined?

Answer:

The Prime Minister had advised Ministers that it is no longer necessary to consult him on officials' overseas travel over \$50,000.

The Prime Minister considered that there had been improvements in efficiency in overseas travel by officials and significant cost savings as a result of Ministerial scrutiny.
