Question:

What amount has been expended on the Prime Minister's temporary accommodation in Canberra since 18 September 2013?

Answer:

Refer to PM 80 (Additional Estimates 2014).

When the Prime Minister is in Canberra he stays at the Australian Federal Police (AFP) College at a cost of \$110 per night, which is paid by the Department of Finance.

For the period 1 October 2013 to 28 February 2015, the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet has made contributions towards Foxtel and covered ADSL services, at a cost of approximately \$365 and \$604 respectively.
