Question:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September 2015:

1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments? List each item of expenditure and cost.
2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes.

Answer:

1. Since 14 September 2015, Finance has engaged service providers to deliver specialist workplace ergonomic assessments at a cost of \$5,580.00. These assessments resulted in the provision of the following:

Ergonomic mouse	1	\$145.00
Monitor riser	1	\$24.50
Mouse Pads	3	\$17.85
Document holder	4	\$288.00
Ergonomic keyboard	1	\$132.00
Sit-to-stand workstation	1	\$699.00
Total		\$5,046.35
