Topic: Staffing profile

Senator LUDWIG asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. Has there been any change to the staffing profile of the department/agency?
2. Provide a list of changes to staffing numbers, broken down by classification level, division, home base location (including town/city and state)

Answer:

The department has not undergone any structural changes since 14 September 2015. Recruitment to fill vacancies as they arise continues and the following three positions have been created in this period:

- Assistant Director, Senators' Services, Black Rod's Office (ongoing), Parliamentary Executive Level 1
- Project Officer, Black Rod's Office (non-ongoing) – Australian Parliamentary Service Level 6;
- Senior Research Officer, Procedure Office (non-ongoing) Australian Parliamentary Service Level 6.

In addition, the number of employees in the Committee Office has increased commensurate with the workload from approximately 61 FTE to 69 FTE.

All employees work from Parliament House, Canberra.
