Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September 2015:

- 1 How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
 - a List each item of expenditure and cost.
- 2 Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
 - a If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes.

Answer

- 1 For the period 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016, the Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) spent \$660 (GST exclusive) on two workplace ergonomic assessments.
- 2 For the period 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016, the PBO spent \$374.29 (GST exclusive) on ergonomic equipment resulting from the assessments referred to in (1), comprising:
