Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
 - a. List each item of expenditure and cost
- 2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
 - a. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

Answer

- 1. Between 14 September 2015 and 31 January 2016, \$5,160 was spend on workplace ergonomic assessments:
 - a. 13 workplace ergonomic assessments ranging in price between \$330 \$620.
- 2. Each assessment resulted in a change ranging from simple adjustments of desks or chairs to the purchase of specialised ergonomic equipment.
