Topic: Report Printing

Senator LUDWIG asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. Have any reports, budget papers, statements, white papers or report-like documents printed for or by the department been pulped, put in storage, shredded or disposed of?
2. If so please give details; name of report, number of copies, cost of printing, who order the disposal, reason for disposal

Answer:

The department has not pulped, put in storage, shredded or disposed of any reports, budget papers, statements, white papers or report-like documents printed for the department since 14 September 2015.

In this period, four reports of Senate Committees printed by the department (in total 398 copies) were reprinted on the authorisation of the relevant committees following the identification of errors in the reports. The total cost of reprinting was \$2,643.
