Topic: Staffing recruitment Written: 23 February 2016

Senator LUDWIG asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September 2015:

- 1 How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 2 How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 3 How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer

- For the period 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016, the Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) recruited seven ongoing employees (one Parliamentary Executive Level (PEL) 2, three PEL1, two Parliamentary Service Level (PSL) 6 and one PSL5.
- 2 During the period 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016, the PBO had two non-ongoing positions at the PEL1 classification.
- During the period 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016, the PBO engaged one non-ongoing employee for approximately two months and another employee for 14 months.
