Mr Gibson: I am not sure what the restriction would have been in the past in providing information on where low aromatic fuel was available at the community level. I will take it on notice, and we will provide what information—

- Goldfields region (WA)
- Gulf of Carpentaria (Qld)
- Western Cape York (Qld)
