Senator WONG: You will be very pleased to know that I am going to have to leave soonish. You are taking me through financial year by financial year from 2013 and you are giving me global costs, but what I would like at the end is to have each of those broken down into the staffing and—what are the other components?

Ms Larkins: Expert advisory panel costs and other expenses; so other administrative expenses like travel.

Senator WONG: Are you able to do that?

Ms Larkins: No, I cannot. I can do that globally—that is, I can give you the total cost over 2014 and 2016, but not each of those components by year. And I can take that on notice.
