Senator McALLISTER: You describe a process of providing advice. Has it been put to you that you might assume responsibility for that service or any aspect of it?

Mr Del Rio: I am just trying to think about what the implications of that are. I think that there are ongoing discussions on the appropriate role of the DTO in all manner of services, and myGov would be caught up in that, I am sure.

Senator McGrath: Why do we not take it on notice? That is probably the best thing to do.

Senator McALLISTER: It would surprise me, if it was under discussion, that it was not obvious to the acting CEO, but we can take it on notice if that is how you would prefer to proceed.

Senator McGrath: I think it would be more helpful.
