- 1. When was the decision taken not to renew the catering contract(s) held by IHG, which expired on 31 December 2016?
- 2. When was the decision made not to approach the market but to assume responsibility for the management of catering outlets within the Department of Parliamentary Services?
- 3. When was IHG informed that there would be no opportunity to extend the contract?

Answer

1-3 The contract required any decision to extend the contract to be taken by 30 June 2016. The Presiding Officers provided in principle approval to transition to an in-house catering model on 13 April 2016 subject to detailed submission for final approval. IHG was informed that the existing contract would not be renewed at a meeting with IHG and DPS on 2 May 2016.
