# Date set by the committee for the return of answer: 13 April 2017

1. Is it correct that the Department of Parliamentary Services agreed to variations in the contract with Limro in the past?

For example, the answer to question on notice 32 from the 2015-16 Budget Estimates in May 2015 indicates a variation to the current contract in order to accommodate increased rates of pay.

2. Why has the Department of Parliamentary Services not pursued a variation in the contract to resolve this protracted and unnecessary dispute?

## **Answer**

1. Yes. There have been 15 deeds of variation to the current contract with Limro.

The variation referred to in the question above followed a request from Limro for a variation to the contract to reflect increased labour costs following Limro's signing of the *Clean Start Union Collective Agreement 2009* effective from 1 January 2010.

DPS wrote to Limro and advised that 'in the current contract the only provision for cost increase relates to the annual CPI increases and any changes to the contract will have to be agreed to by both parties. While DPS has not received additional funds to cover cost increases associated with Clean Start, in accordance with Section 3 of the Fair Work Principles DPS is prepared to consult with its suppliers to consider appropriate contract variations on a case-by-case basis.'


Limro was asked to identify areas where the current contract could be varied without compromising the overall quality of the cleaning, for example the frequency of some cleaning items. These items would then be priced and used to find savings to assist Limro in offsetting the increased labour costs.

Subsequently, following meetings with Limro during 2011, a list of cleaning items that could be reduced in frequency or removed from the statement of requirement, and the resultant savings was identified. The identified changes equated to a saving of \$65,749.69 per annum to Limro Cleaning Services, on the basis that Limro would use the amount to fund staff pay increases.

A Deed of Variation reflecting these changes was signed by DPS and Limro in February 2012. The Deed of Variation with Limro is attached; this variation was for a reduction of services only. The value of the contract did not change and therefore gazettal on AusTender was not required.

2. As stated above the only provision in the current contract to vary the cost of the contract relates to the annual CPI increase.

The areas to be cleaned have not been varied since the February 2012 Deed of Variation.

**COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA** as represented by the Department of Parliamentary Services (DPS) ABN 52 997 141 147, Parliament House, PO Box 6000, Canberra ACT 2600

AND

**LIMRO Pty Ltd** ABN: 93 002 477 189, an Australian company incorporated in accordance with the Corporations Law and having its registered office at Unit 3, 11 Fitzroy Street, FORREST ACT 2603 ("**the Contractor**")

#### **PURPOSE**

- A The Contractor and DPS entered into Contract JH03024 ("**the Contract**") dated 1 July 2003, for the Provision of Cleaning Services at Parliament House.
- B DPS now wishes to vary certain rights and obligations contained in the Contract in the form of this Deed of Variation.

## IT IS AGREED

- 1. To vary the Contract as follows:
  - 1.1 DPS in its sole discretion exercises its right to

Clause 31 (b) empty waste/garbage and paper bins, replace bin liner bags at least twice per day and as required (Monday to Friday);

Clause 31 (b) empty waste/garbage, co-mingling and paper bins, replace bin liner bags at least twice per day, and as required (Monday to Friday);

Clause 31 (e) six-monthly, defrost and clean refrigerators.

#### with:

Clause 31 (e) annually, defrost and clean refrigerators.

Clause 32 (b) empty waste/garbage and paper bins, replace bin liner bags at least twice per day and as required (Monday to Friday);

Clause 54 (f) three monthly - machine scrub pavers on lunchroom patios.

## delete:

Clause 55 (a) defrost refrigerators in suites, offices, tea rooms, and attendants' rooms;

Clause 55 (b) clean inside of kitchen cupboards;

Clause 55 (d) remove dust and any litter from underneath false floor in computer room, Sound and Vision Centre, Telecom PABX and Ministerial Communications Room.

Clause 56 Full clean of timber venetian blinds.

2. In all other respects the terms and conditions of the Contract remain unaltered.
