Topic: Inadvertent disclosure of mobile telephone numbers

With reference to the inadvertent disclosure of mobile telephone numbers of many parliamentarians and their staff published in the Parliamentarians' Mobile and Telecommunications and Data Services Expenditure reports:

- a) When was the private contractor, TELCO Management, awarded the contract to manage aspects of the Parliamentarians' Mobile and Telecommunications and Data Services Expenditure reports?
- b) What is the duration of the contract?
- c) What is the value of the contract?
- d) What responsibilities does TELCO Management hold under the contract?

Answer

- a) 11 February 2014. The company at that time was trading under the name Vizibill, but has since undertaken a merger and is now trading as TELCO Management.
- b) 31 months with the option, which has been exercised, to extend the contract on a month by month basis.
- c) \$107,250. The monthly payment under the contract is \$2,500 per month. So far a total of \$90,750 has been expended against the contract (as at 31 March 2017).
- d) The contract involves reporting on telecommunication usage and charges for all parliamentary departments as well as parliamentarians and their staff. Specifically the services provided in the contact are as follows:
 - Word and PDF formatted report provided, enabling the Department of Parliamentary Services to publish parliamentarian's mobile device and data expenditure as legislated.
 - Reporting periods. January to June July to December. Reports to be provided first week of each reporting period.
 - Continually plan for the evolution of the reports and modify the manner in which the reports are supplied (subject to any variations to a Contract required to implement any change) to improve the quality, effectiveness and efficiency of the reports and their delivery.
