## Activity


In the 45th Parliament, at 16 February 2017, there have been:

- 107 references (81 new references and 26 re-adopted from the 44th Parliament);
- 68 reports tabled;
- 90 hearings.



#### Standing Committee references in the first 5.5 months of each Parliament




#### Standing Committee references by financial year





#### Additional indicators of activity:

- The department is currently supporting five select committees, with another pending. During
  the 44<sup>th</sup> Parliament, the department supported 12 select committees (including one
  committee later re-established).
- · At present, the department also supports six joint committees.
- The busiest committee during the 44<sup>th</sup> Parliament was the Economics Committee, which managed 20 inquiries in February 2016, and 18 in September and in November 2015.


# Staffing

Average staffing for 2016–17: At 8 February 2017 there were 68.6 Full Time Equivalent staff in the Committee Office, compared with an average FTE of 66.8 for 2015-16.

## Administration

Cost of running Senate committees: The current annual budget for the Committee Office is approximately \$8.8 million. At 31 January 2017, the 2016–17 year-to-date operational costs for the office were \$4.7 million.

In 2015–16, operational costs for the Committee Office were \$10.7 million (including corporate overheads). Additional resources were sought and used in the last financial year.
