- a) The Minister for Indigenous Affairs, Senator the Hon Nigel Scullion, discussed opportunities to support the Aboriginal Housing Company at a meeting in July 2015. The Minister for Indigenous Affairs, Senator the Hon Nigel Scullion, publicly announced the grant in a media release on 27 August 2015.
- b) The \$5 million grant offered to the Aboriginal Housing Company is contingent on the affordable housing component of the development progressing at the same time as the commercial component and that Aboriginal Housing Company gets the appropriate skills to manage the project. The terms of the grant offer were made known to the Aboriginal Housing Company in August 2015.
