Question:

- 1. Can you explain how the measure entitled "Communications and Public Affairs Functions targeted savings" on page 113 of Budget Paper Number Two of the 2014-15 Budget will work in practice?
- 2. What does it mean to have "more efficient practices for public affairs and internal communications within Australian Government agencies"?
- 3. Have you issued guidance or information to agencies to help them implement this measure?

Answer:

- 1. The savings over the forward estimates will be achieved by applying a reduction in estimated communications expenditure across portfolio agencies of 2.5 per cent in 2014–15 and 5 per cent in 2015–16, 2016–17 and 2017–18. The implementation of those savings will be determined by individual Portfolio Secretaries and Chief Executives of other affected agencies.
- 2. It is a matter for affected agencies to consider and implement more efficient practices for communications and public affairs, noting the wide range of functions provided across those agencies on a day-to-day basis.
- 3. As at 31 May 2014, no guidance or information had been issued to agencies.
