Senator LUDWIG: ... Can you provide to the committee the individual funding profiles for each of the 112 programs that go to making up the \$165 billion over the four years? **Senator Cormann:** I think what we can quite easily provide you with is the list of the relevant 112 administered programs. We may be able to table that. It is actually already available on the website. We might have to take on notice the breakdown—

Senator LUDWIG: Just so I can understand why you picked 1 July this year and not all 1 July 2015, given the way these things work. The level of funding remains available per year for each program after the indexation pause, so—

Mr Tune: We will try.

Senator LUDWIG: Yes, I know that that is a bit harder.

Mr Tune: It is a huge amount of work. We will do what we can for you.

Senator LUDWIG: Come back to me on that one then. If you can provide an explanation without going to the work, we can always then negotiate if there are one or two that I might want to examine in greater detail.

Senator Cormann: Once the feedback from the department comes back to you, I might approach you in the chamber and we will discuss how to take it from there.

Answer:

The attached table provides the profile and commencement date of savings for each of the 112 programmes.

The commencement date for the indexation pause is 1 July 2014 for all programmes except those in the Health area, as funds had generally been committed for these programmes for 2014-15.
