- 1. Do the reports by the COAG Reform Council place any requirements on the States or Commonwealth to deliver on a given measure or to take any further actions?
- 2. The Council lists a number of reports on its website. Are these reports printed? What is the cost of having these reports printed?
- 3. Who are the reports distributed to? What is the distribution cost?

Answer:

- 1. No.
- 2. A small number of reports are printed and bound in-house, with report covers being professionally printed. The cost of printing report covers from 1 July 2013 to 1 May 2014 was \$4,182.75.
- 3. Reports are distributed to first ministers, journalists at media launches and a small number of stakeholders. The only direct cost for distributing the reports is postage. The average cost to distribute the full set of each report ranges from \$69.70 to \$133.15.
