1. Where in Sydney is the COAG Reform Council based?

2. What was the total cost to taxpayers of the Council's rent or lease arrangement in its Sydney office?

Answer:

- 1. The COAG Reform Council was based at Level 24, 6 O'Connell Street, Sydney, New South Wales until it was abolished on 30 June 2014.
- 2. The total cost of the COAG Reform Council's lease arrangement from 2007–08 to 2013–14 was \$2,574,639. The extended lease runs from 15 August 2014 to 14 August 2017, at a total cost of \$1,827,000. The department is taking active steps to sub-lease the office accommodation. Also see PM99.
